GIFT AID DECLARATION

Gift Aid is a scheme introduced by the Chancellor that allows the Presbyterian Church to recover some of the tax you have paid when you make a donation to the Church. The value of your gift to the Church increases at no cost to you.

To be eligible to participate you must pay sufficient United Kingdom tax (Income or Capital Gains) to cover the amount the church will reclaim on your donation. For the 2000/2001 tax year this is 28p for every £1 donated.

Please return the completed Gift Aid Declaration slip to the Covenant Secretary. The Church will record your donations given under the scheme and recover an amount equal to basic rate tax to those donations.

You can cancel at any time by contacting your congregational treasurer/covenant secretary. The Church will not recover tax on donations made once your cancellation notice has been received.

Notes:

1. For the scheme to work all donations given by you must be identifiable as coming from you, either through using FWO or other gift envelopes, a cheque or standing order. Loose cash placed in the collection plate cannot be included in Gift Aid.
2. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim a further reduction in your self assessment tax return.
