NEWTOWNABBEY FOODBANK

Newtownabbey Foodbank opened in April 2015 and in those two years we have fed 3492 Adults and 2922 Children. This has

only been possible through the generosity of congregations who donate food every Sunday. A very big Thank You to everyone in Carnmoney who has donated food to this caring Ministry as you have enabled us to help the many vulnerable people who need our support.

To sustain the Foodbank we need to fundraise so we are asking for your support. At this time of the year many of you travel and return with foreign currency. We would be grateful if you would consider donating this currency, which will then be exchanged into sterling for the Foodbank. A bucket will be available at the desk in the vestibule.

Each month we will also be asking if you would consider donating specific items, which will help maintain the Warehouse stock. This month we would be really grateful for donations of Tinned Tomatoes, Coffee and UHT Milk.

We now have 117 volunteers working in the four Distribution Centres at Carnmoney Church, Abbotcross Presbyterian, Ballyclare Presbyterian, Greencastle Methodist and the Warehouse in Carnmoney.
