CAN YOU HELP?

Over 1000 children and teenagers attend activities at Carnmoney in a normal week. This is awesome, but it means we constantly need to grow our teams. So, if you have a passion for passing on faith to the next generation, have time and are willing to commit to our teams then please consider serving in youth and children's at Carnmoney from September. FRIDAY FUSION

Beginning September 21st; minimum commitment of 2 nights per month. Friday Fusion is a drop-in ministry for teenagers which launched last year. It is all about creating a welcoming space where teenagers can hang out, stay safe and be exposed to the love God has for them through meaningful relationships. If you care about sharing Jesus with an unchurched generation then this might be for you.

YOUTH ALPHA

Sunday 23rd September for 10 weeks. We are anticipating a good turn out at and need to supplement the Fusion team with extra helpers to allow us to deliver the course really well.

Here are some things we need help with: registration and welcoming people

- small group helpers
- security around the site
- people to pray throughout the night
- making and serving food

FAQ's: Voluntary Internship - Northern Ireland

How many places are there on the voluntary internship programme?

We're on the lookout for 2 individuals to join our programme starting in September 2018.

Due to the expected popularity of our programme, we encourage applicants to apply early to avoid disappointment. This is a 10 month internship finishing at the end of June 2019.

What roles are available?

We have two voluntary internship roles:

- **Publicity** – This role will involve creating press and publicity opportunities and is ideally suited to someone interested in or studying journalism or PR.
- **Events and Church Engagement** - This role will involve planning and delivering local CAP events as well as creating opportunities to promote CAP's services to the local Church.

How do I apply?

Is there a deadline for applications?

The closing date for applications is 5pm on **Monday 31st July**. We don't want you to miss out, so we recommend you apply as early as possible.

When do interviews take place?

We will invite successful applicants to an assessment day in Belfast, which is being held on **Wednesday 8th August**. On this day you'll have an interview, participate in a group activity and get to hear more about CAP's vision and mission.

Where is the internship based?

You'll join our passionate team of Christians, who share your heart for the poor, at CAP's Northern Ireland office in Belfast. Here you'll spend your time working as a key member of our local team. You will also be able to take advantage of webinars, online seminars, coaching and input from the leadership team with others on the Head Office programme. You will also be required to travel to Bradford to undertake training within our Head Office.

When does the internship start?

The internship will start on 3rd September and your first 3 days will be in Bradford (3rd-5th September). After this you will be in our Belfast office.

Is the internship voluntary or employed?

This is a voluntary internship. You'll receive free top quality teaching, training and investment from a range of leaders within CAP, and have an exciting and varied role. It's a year to really grow in your knowledge, learning and leadership.

What hours do I volunteer?

There is flexibility in volunteer hours and days – ideally we are seeking two interns who can commit to volunteer 3 days per week (22.5 hours). The normal volunteer hours of the internship are throughout our working week - Monday to Friday, 8:45am to 5pm. There are lots of other optional things you can choose to get involved with as well, such as volunteering at CAP training days and supporter events.
