WOMEN'S WORLD DAY OF PRAYER – FRIDAY 1ST MARCH 2019

This year in the Newtownabbey area there will be only one meeting which will be held as follows:

GLENGORMLEY PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH AT 10.30 AM. THEME: "EVERYTHING IS READY"

This year's service has been prepared by the Christian women in Slovenia, which is one of the smallest and youngest countries in Europe, and we will be encouraged to reflect on the barriers they have faced since the end of the Second World War when their country was part of Yugoslavia, a Marxist socialist republic. The Day of Prayer is celebrated in over 120 countries. It begins in Samoa and prayer in native languages travels throughout the world – through Asia, Africa, the Middle East, Europe and the Americas before finishing in American Samoa some 38 hours later.

So, ladies of Carnmoney, let us join in this celebration of prayer with so many women all around the world by making an effort to be present on Friday 1st March. Tea and coffee will be served afterwards so there will be a chance to have fellowship with ladies from nine other churches in our area.
